



Avalon Park Orlando 4th of July: Know Before You Go

General Information

Q: Where do festivals take place?

A: Avalon Park Orlando festivals are held throughout Downtown Avalon Park, including Town Park, the Marketplace at Avalon Park, and Founders Square, located at **3801 Avalon Park East Blvd, Orlando, FL 32828**.

Q: How much does it cost?

A: The 4th of July event is free and open to the public.

Q: What if it rains?

A: Our Events are rain or shine unless otherwise announced. In the event of severe weather, updates will be posted on AvalonParkOrlando.com and our social media channels @AvalonParkOrlando.

Parking

Q: Where is event parking?

A: Parking is available in surrounding lots throughout Downtown Avalon Park, including Avalon Elementary School, Tanja King Park, Avalon Middle School and the Grass Flagpole lot.

Q: Is there a cost to park?

A: No, not at this time, parking is currently free for community events.

Scooters, Bikes & Wheels

Q: Are scooters allowed?

A: No. For the safety of all attendees, scooters (including electric scooters) are not permitted within event area, during event hours.

Q: Are bikes allowed?

A: Bicycles are welcome for transportation to the event but should be parked in designated bike racks or walked through event area, not ridden through crowded areas.

Q: What about strollers and wagons?

A: Strollers and wagons are welcome and encouraged for families! Please be mindful of crowd flow and other attendees.

Restrooms

Q: Where are the restrooms located?

A: Public restrooms are available at the Town Park Ampitheater (3651 Avalon Park East Blvd.) and port-o-lets located in the parking lot behind the Marketplace at Avalon Park (3801 Avalon Park East Blvd.).

Q: Are there accessible restrooms?

A: Yes, ADA accessible restrooms are available at each of the public restroom facilities.

Accessibility

Q: Is the festival ADA accessible?

A: Yes. The event is accessible via paved walkways. If you have specific accessibility needs, please reach out ahead of the event so we can better assist you.

Q: Are service animals allowed?

A: Yes, service animals are welcome. Please see our pet policy below for general pets.

Pets

Q: Can I bring my pet?

A: Pets are welcome at most outdoor festivals but must be leashed at all times. Please be mindful of crowds, noise levels (especially during fireworks), and clean up after your pet.

Bag Policy & Security

Q: Is there a bag policy?

A: We recommend bringing only what you need. Bags may be subject to inspection for the safety of all attendees.

Q: Are outside chairs and blankets allowed?

A: Yes! Lawn chairs and blankets are welcome for open lawn areas.

Food & Drink

Q: Can I bring outside food or drinks?

A: Outside food and drinks are generally permitted in open community spaces; however, we encourage supporting our local food trucks and vendors!

Q: Is alcohol allowed?

A: Alcohol is only permitted if purchased through licensed vendors at the event and must be consumed within designated areas.

We also encourage all attendees to stay hydrated throughout the event, especially during warm weather.

Smoking

Q: Is smoking permitted?

A: Smoking, including vaping, is not permitted in the event area, particularly near children's activities.

Lost & Found / Emergency

Q: What if I lose an item?

A: Please bring all lost items or inquire about found items at the Marketplace at Avalon Park, located at 3801 Avalon Park E Blvd. Lost and found items will be held and can be claimed through Avalon Park Group after the event.

Q: Is there medical assistance on-site?

A: Yes, the first aid tent is located on Avalon Lake Drive, just outside of Pepe's Cantina.

Q: What if I have an emergency?

A: For any emergency, please contact 911 immediately.

Kids Activities & Fireworks

Q: Are there activities for kids?

A: Yes! Most festivals include bounce houses, kids' crafts, face painting, and other family-friendly activations.

Q: Is there a fee to participate?

A: There is no cost to participate in the bounce park; however, registration is required at the Journey Booth, located at the entrance of the bounce park on Avalon Lake Drive. All other activities are available for a fee, based on the vendor providing the service.

Q: Where will the fireworks go off?

A: The fireworks will be shot from Avalon Lake, in the center of the event. The lawn areas surrounding Avalon Lake offer the best views for fireworks displays. Arrive early to secure your spot.

Bounce House Protocol & Check-In

Q: Do I need to check in to use the bounce houses?

A: All children must be checked in by a parent or guardian at the designated bounce house check-in table before entering any inflatable attraction. A liability waiver must be signed at check-in.

Q: Is there an age or height requirement?

A: Yes. Each bounce house will have age, height, and weight restrictions. Please follow the guidelines at each individual unit, as requirements may vary by attraction.

Q: What are the rules once inside?

A: Shoes, jewelry, glasses, food, and drinks must be removed before entering. No flips, climbing on walls, or rough play. Smaller children should be separated from larger or older children when possible. Attendants may pause entry during high winds or inclement weather for safety.

Q: Is parent supervision required?

A: Avalon Park staff and attendants will be on-site to monitor capacity and enforce safety rules, but it remains the parent or guardian's responsibility to supervise their child's participation and wellbeing throughout use.

Q: What if my child gets hurt while using a bounce house?

A: Please notify the nearest staff member or attendant immediately. First aid stations are available on-site for minor incidents.
